

SAT Test Dates and Registration Deadlines

A. Register On-Line Directly

1. Fill out the registration form online at:
sat.collegeboard.org/register/sat-international-dates
2. Upload a photo
(See the website for instructions.)
3. Pay the test fees by credit card.

If you register on-line, you must **opt-in** to receive a paper score report form. Otherwise, you will not receive a paper score report by mail. The only score report you will get is on-line.

B. Register in Person at AMIDEAST

1. Fill out the registration form using a pen.
2. Present a photo of minimum size 5.5 x 5.5 cm
(Your appearance in the photo must match how you look on the test day.)
3. Present your identification document
4. Pay the test fees:

SAT Reasoning Test (with essay): \$112.00
SAT Reasoning Test (without essay): \$ 97.00
SAT Subject Test (3 tests): \$139.00

If you register in person, you will automatically get a paper score report. However, if you create an online account, you must also select whether or not you want to receive a paper score report via mail, as the online account overrides any previous information in the College Board's database.

Important Notes:

- If you have an online account, regardless of which method you used to register, you must **make sure to opt-in** if you want to receive a paper score report.
