

To apply for admissions at **LAU** you need to submit an undergraduate application (online or hard copy) with the following

Required documents:

- A recent passport-size photo
- A clear photocopy of your identity card or passport. (should be the same as the nationality to be used in the registration process at LAU)
- An official high school transcript of the last three years
- Certified copies of all official certificates or diplomas when available
- Official SAT I scores
- Non-refundable fee of \$85 for paper application and \$65 for the online application
- Proof of English proficiency by submitting ONE of the below:
 - Official scores of the TOEFL; LAU's code is 2595
 - Official scores of the IELTS
 - English Entrance Exam (EEE) administered at LAU
 - SAT I Writing section (Learn how to send your SAT scores)
 - Check the minimum required scores

Additional required documents for Lebanese students applying to sophomore program

- Lebanese students with non-Lebanese diplomas must also submit the Equivalence of Lebanese Baccalaureate from the Ministry of Education when available.

Additional required documents for Lebanese students applying to freshman program

- Copy of the exemption from the Lebanese program
- SAT I and SAT II scores with a minimum combined score as set by the Ministry of Education:
 - Freshman Arts: Math I and any other two subjects, not less than 2150 total score
 - Freshman Science: Math II and two of the following subjects: Biology, Chemistry, or Physics, not less than 2300 total score
- The ability to declare a major in a B.A. or B.S. program and joining the sophomore class will only be done once you satisfy both 1) the Lebanese Baccalaureate equivalency requirements set by the Lebanese Ministry of Education and 2) the freshman requirements set by LAU.

English Entrance Exam (EEE)

The Office of Testing Services administers the English Entrance Exam (EEE). The EEE tests the English-language knowledge you have acquired in high school and measures your level of proficiency.

To register for the test, please provide:

1. Two (2) passport-size photos per exam
2. An original identity card (هوية), personal civil Status Record, or passport (For checking purposes)
3. L.L. 90,000, or \$60, testing fee
4. Registration should be done in person

Please note the following:

- Students may register and sit for exams on either campus with no restrictions.
- Testing sessions can accommodate a maximum of 160 students in Byblos and 225 in Beirut. Once a session is full, you will automatically be registered for the next available session.
- In cases of extreme need or emergency, the EEE can be taken on a date other than those displayed in the tables below at the rate of \$80 per test.
- If you want to re-take the EEE, you must wait at least one month between tests.
- Please view the minimum required score.

English Proficiency exams

English is the official language of instruction at LAU and applicants must demonstrate their proficiency in the language by submitting the official scores of ONE of following tests:

Note: The minimum scores for all entrance exams may be changed without prior notice.

Based on your test results, you may be required to take, or may be exempted from, certain courses at LAU. The chart below explains the basic rules:

Your score	Placement rules
EEE 400–449 Internet-based TOEFL 55–65 Redesigned SAT I Writing 18-20 IELTS 5.5	You will be placed in the Intensive English Program and start with ENG002 (Intensive English II) . Your next course would be ENG003 (Intensive English III). You are not allowed to start with the major courses.
EEE 450–499 Internet-based TOEFL 66–79 Redesigned SAT I Writing 21-22 IELTS 6	You will be placed in the Intensive English Program and start with ENG003 (Intensive English III) . You are not allowed to start with the major courses.
EEE 500–549 Internet-based TOEFL 80–89 Redesigned SAT I Writing 23-26 IELTS 6.5	The first English course you have to register for is ENG009 (Remedial English) , a non-credit course (three hours of instruction weekly, but no credits are counted)
EEE 550–599 Internet-based TOEFL 90–100 Redesigned SAT I Writing 27-29 IELTS 7	The first English course you have to register for is ENG101 (Academic English I) . You are exempt from ENG009 (Remedial English).
EEE 600–649 Internet-based TOEFL 101–110 Redesigned SAT I Writing 30-32 IELTS 7.5	The first English course you have to register for is ENG102 (Academic English II) . You are exempt from ENG009 (Remedial English) and ENG101 (Academic English I).
EEE 650 & above Internet-based TOEFL 111 & above Redesigned SAT I Writing 33 & above IELTS 8 & above	The first English course you have to register for is ENG 202 (Advanced Academic English) . You are exempt from ENG009 (Remedial English), ENG101 (Academic English I), and ENG102 (Academic English II).

The EEE is given several times each semester, and each testing session has a corresponding registration deadline. Please check the date, registration deadline, and location carefully below.
